# 2021 IMPROVEMENTS AT PATRIOT POINT

It was a busy year at Patriot Point, with improvements throughout the property, starting with the new flagpoles that were erected on New Year's Day. Pavers were laid, completing the driveway and walkway in front of the Main House.

Inside the Main House, nearly all of the interior was repainted. The third-floor Reflection Room was completely overhauled. Redecorating throughout remains in process. Furniture is on the way for the Hemingway Room and the living room. The Guest House was repainted and guests staying there sleep soundly on new bedding. A new handrail was installed on the steps to the Welcome Center. The gazebo is being rescreened.

Around the property, blinds were rebuilt, drainage was improved and a new shooting range was installed. The Patriot Point Pro Shop opened. The five-stand clay sporting throwers are being replaced with a new system from Lincoln Traps.

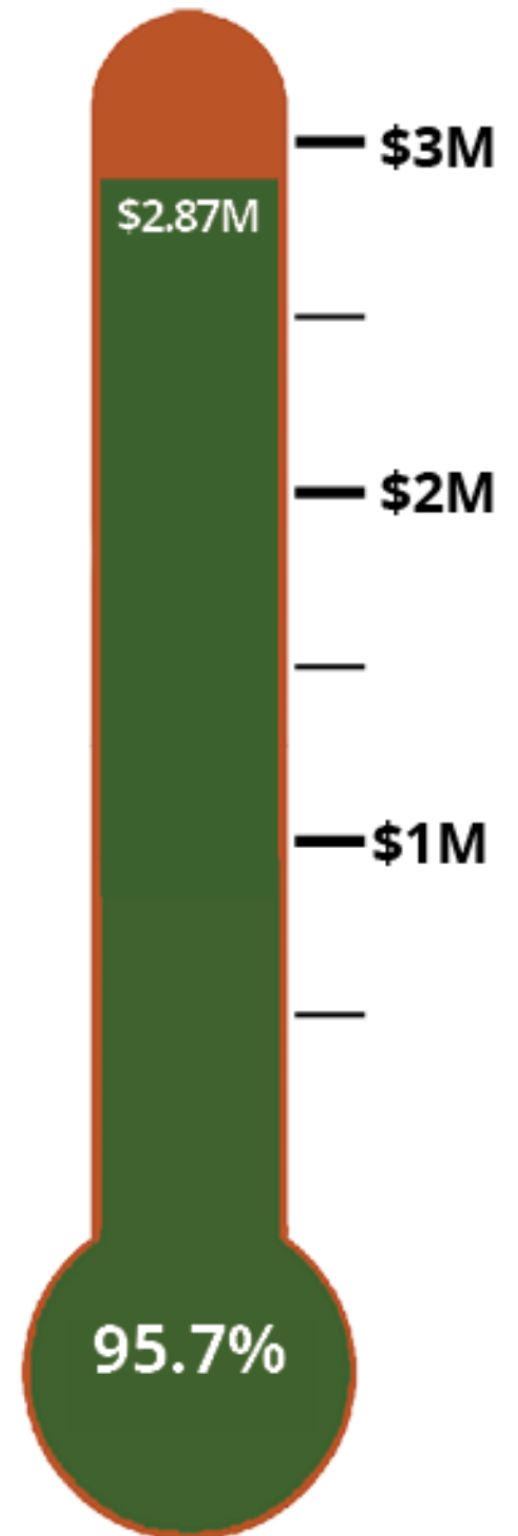
