

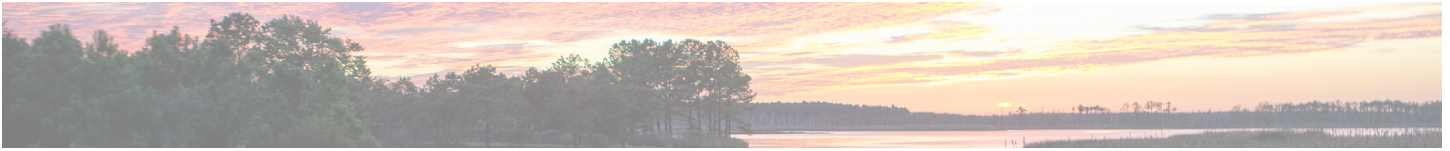

WELCOME TO PATRIOT POINT

Dear Friends of Patriot Point,

This has been a challenging year in nearly every facet of life, but we are incredibly proud of how things have progressed at Patriot Point.

Although the global health pandemic slowed the frequency of guests visiting our 290-acre oasis for recovering service members, their families and caregivers, the commitment to providing a first-class retreat destination and terrific on-site programming did not dwindle.

In fact, it was an amazing year at Patriot Point as we completed the Main House Phase II renovation and other work continues throughout the property. Guests will notice the first difference as they travel down Route 16 approaching Patriot Point: A beautiful new entrance gate with elegant stonework.

Proceeding down the gravel driveway, guests are sure to notice that we are revamping the area in front of the Main House with new landscaping, flagpoles and benches for guests to enjoy. Be sure to look for the personalized pavers leading to the Welcome Center from the Brick by Brick campaign – thank you to those who contributed to this effort!

The Main House itself received a major overhaul. The exterior, which already featured new roofing and siding, has new stonework. The interior has new windows and window treatments, updated electrical wiring, new plumbing and renovated bathrooms, new carpet and wooden flooring. The master bedroom was divided into two bedrooms, increasing our guest capacity.

With all of the work taking place, the ability to host guests was limited. But as projects neared completion, several groups were welcomed to Patriot Point as we continued to partner with other

military and veteran service organizations.

While we look forward to a return to normalcy and affording more service members the chance to relax and enjoy Patriot Point, there is one more change to note. After nearly five years of as Patriot Point resident property manager, Tim Mitchell is retiring and moving to Florida; we would like everyone to meet Hugh Middleton, Patriot Point's new general manager.



A former U.S. Navy SEAL, Hugh has volunteered at Patriot Point and he knows how special Patriot Point is to those who visit. We are pleased to have Hugh on our team and know that he will build on what Tim has done.

We also wanted to give a special thank you to Mike Mattingly and his dedicated team of volunteers who continue to support our mission to provide a relaxing and safe environment for our nation's wounded, ill and injured service members, their families and caregivers to enjoy outdoor recreational activities. 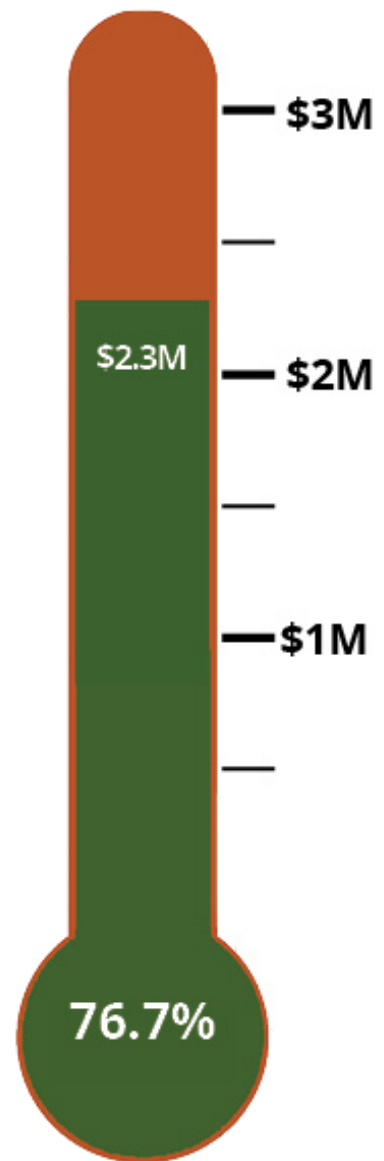

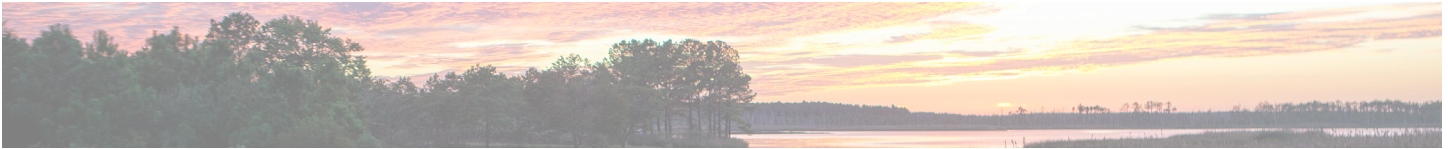
CAMPAIGN FOR PATRIOT POINT

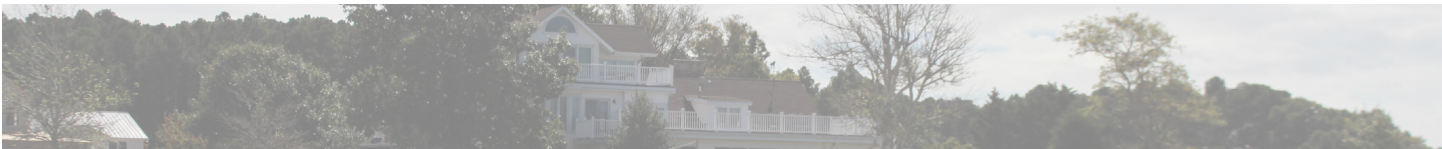

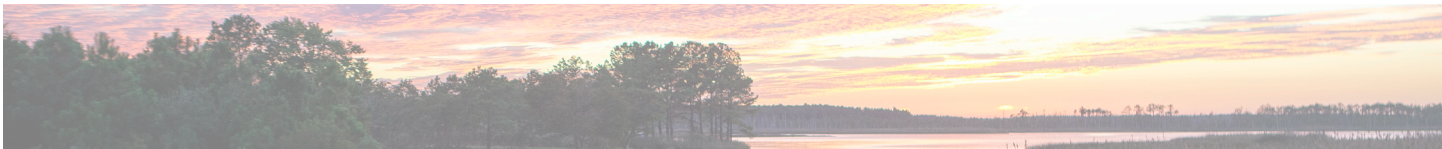
