WELCOME TO PATRIOT POINT

Dear Friends of Patriot Point,

The past year has been very rewarding at Patriot Point, as we welcomed so many guests to the property. As always, it was heartwarming to see the impact that Patriot Point makes on the nation's service members, their families and caregivers.

Let us provide a quick recap.

So far this year, nearly 500 guests have visited Patriot Point, totaling more than 1,200 use days and enjoying all that Patriot Point offers. Some hunted. Others fished. Some hit the water to boat, kayak and paddle board. Others enjoyed the peaceful serenity of the beach and our cozy bonfire pit. More than half of the guests were wounded, ill or injured active-duty or veteran service members.

Whether it was an overnight trip, a weekend stay or a respite covering several days, it was wonderful to see the difference Patriot Point makes. First-time guests often arrive quietly, keeping their thoughts to themselves and wondering what their stay holds. But by the time they pack their belongings to depart, many of these individuals seem totally different. They have made new friends, shared new experiences and realize they are not alone in their journeys.

From a facility perspective, improvements continued throughout the property. The first group of 13 chickens is residing in our new chicken coop, a new greenhouse will be installed in mid-December as work toward offering a farm-to-table experience. Construction on a new barn to store our farm equipment and other large items starts shortly.

Additionally, as we strengthen our leadership, an Advisory Council was formed to ensure the sustainability, growth and the future of Patriot Point.

This does not happen without a strong network of supporters. Special thanks to everyone who donated materials, gave their time, discounted their services or offered to phone a contact and bring them into our circle. What we continue to accomplish is a team effort and we could not do it without such amazing support.

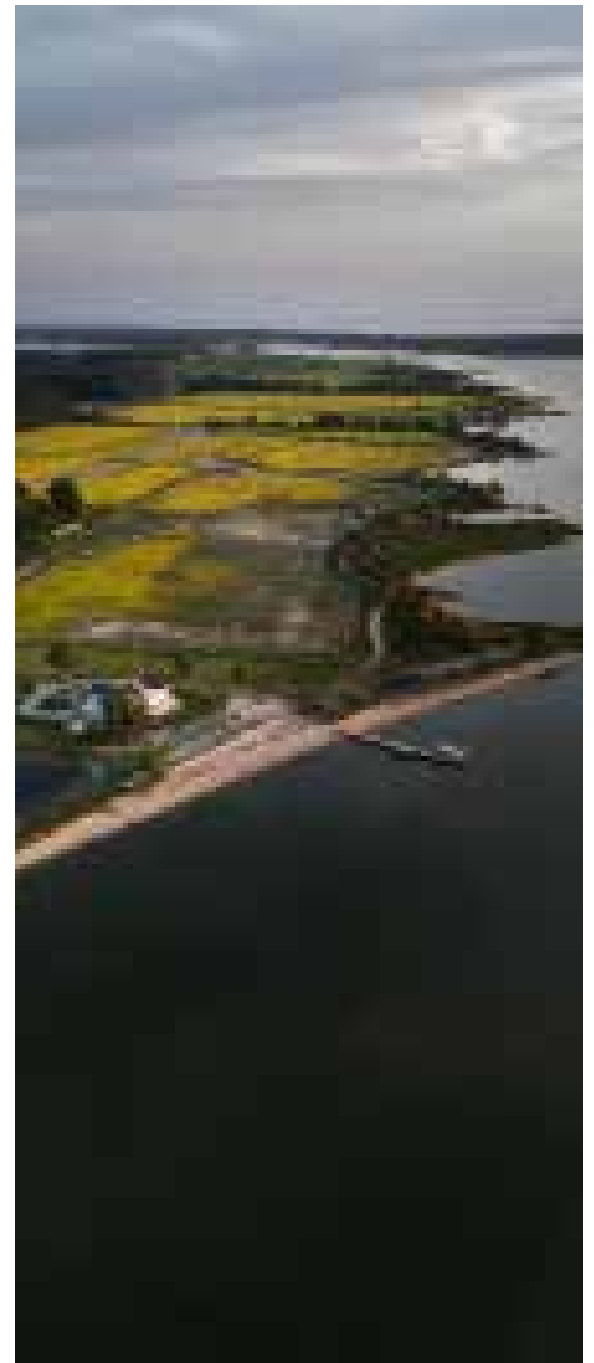

COMMANDERS VETERAN OF THE GAME

Patriot Point Vice President Hugh Middleton was honored as the Washington Commanders "Veteran of the Game" following the first quarter of the Commanders' game against the New York Giants this past Sunday.

Hugh, a former U.S. Navy SEAL Lieutenant Commander, served 14 years during which he was assigned to SEAL Teams One, Three, Five, Naval Special Warfare Development Group (NSWDG) and spent time in various overseas assignments including a Special Operations Joint Staff. He also worked in several U.S. embassies and consulates.

"It was flattering to be recognized by the Commanders," Hugh said. "While standing on the field, I could sense the appreciation of the fans, not just for my service, but also for the service of all of the men and women who have served and continue to put themselves in harm's way."

IN REMEMBRANCE

Patriot Point pays respects to a few individuals who were near and dear to us and passed away this past year.

MIKE HOWELL was a member of the Patriot Point Board of Managers since its inception. He was 59.

"Mike was a cornerstone of Patriot Point from the very beginning," Patriot Point Vice President Hugh Middleton said. "He played a huge role in our growth and what we have become. He loved spending time with our wounded veteran groups, especially during hunting season. He will be sorely missed by everyone."

Howell also was a board member of the Taishoff Family Foundation and Promise Landing Farm. He was active in the DC commercial construction industry and was a principal and vice president of operations for Evans Contracting Group, Inc. He was a graduate of the University of Florida College of Building Construction.

"Mike was a guy that you could always count on and was so willing to share both his time and expertise," Military Bowl Foundation President & Executive Director Steve Beck said. "He played a vital role in helping Patriot Point become an oasis for recovering service members."



JAYNE PLANK was one of Patriot Point's biggest supporters. Her father served in the Marine Corps in World War I; her stepfather served in the Marine Air Corps during World War II. She was accustomed to being around service members while growing up and regularly attended home hospitality dinners hosted by family and friends for those stationed in Washington. It was only natural that when Plank heard about Patriot Point from her son Stuart, that she wanted to help.

"We've always been oriented to the military," Jayne Plank said in a 2022 interview. "Ours is the greatest country of all. Helping our military and caregivers, it's my joy."

Plank spent her career as a public servant. She worked as Director of Intergovernmental Affairs at the U.S. Department of State and as a Cryptologic Linguist for the National Security Agency. She also served on the Kensington Town Council and later was the first woman elected as the town's mayor, for a total of 15 years of service to the town. She has served as a eucharistic minister at the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda and volunteered with the Yellow Ribbon Fund, which is one of Patriot Point's nonprofit partners.



JOE REYDA, a DC Touchdown Club Executive Committee member, was the longtime athletic director at Gonzaga College High School.

"Simply put, Joe was one of the very best," Military Bowl Foundation President & Executive Director Steve Beck said. "Whether it was chipping in to help on a project, coming up with ideas or just being supportive, Joe was always there to lend a hand. He was a leader in the Gonzaga community and positively influenced so many students who passed through its doors.:"

Reyda, a 1985 Gonzaga graduate, worked at his alma mater since 1989 and had served as the school's athletic director since 2001. He also coached golf and football during his 34-year tenure at the school.
